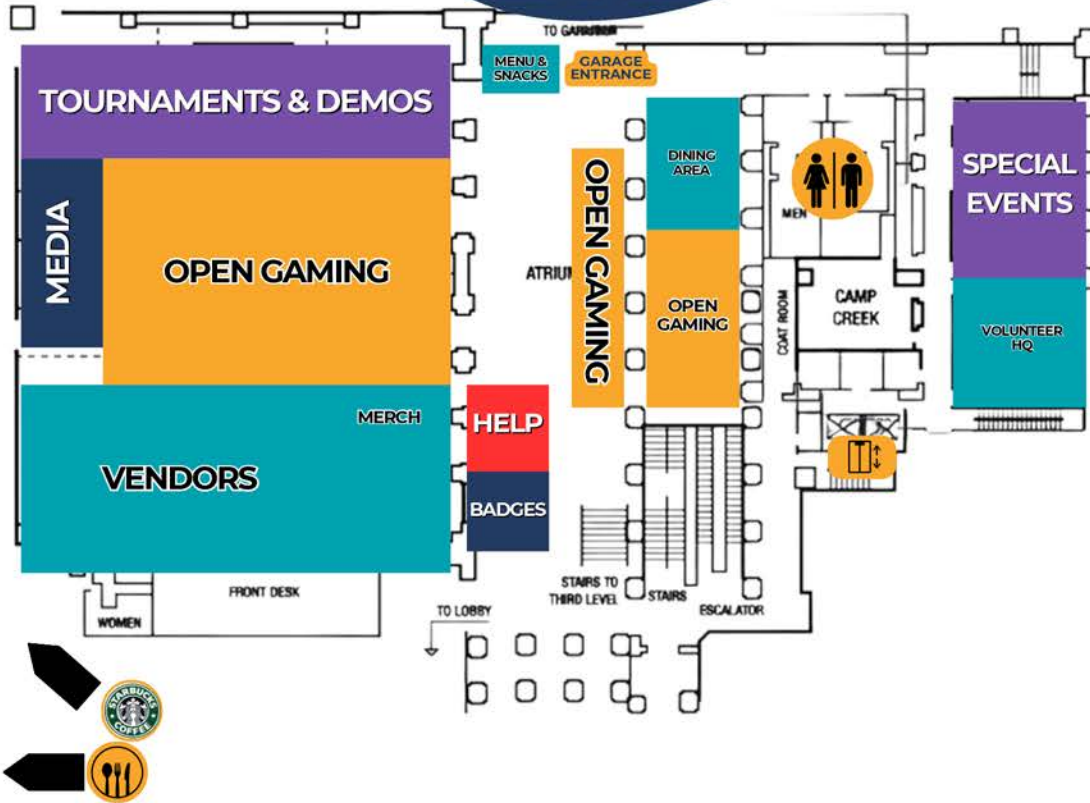

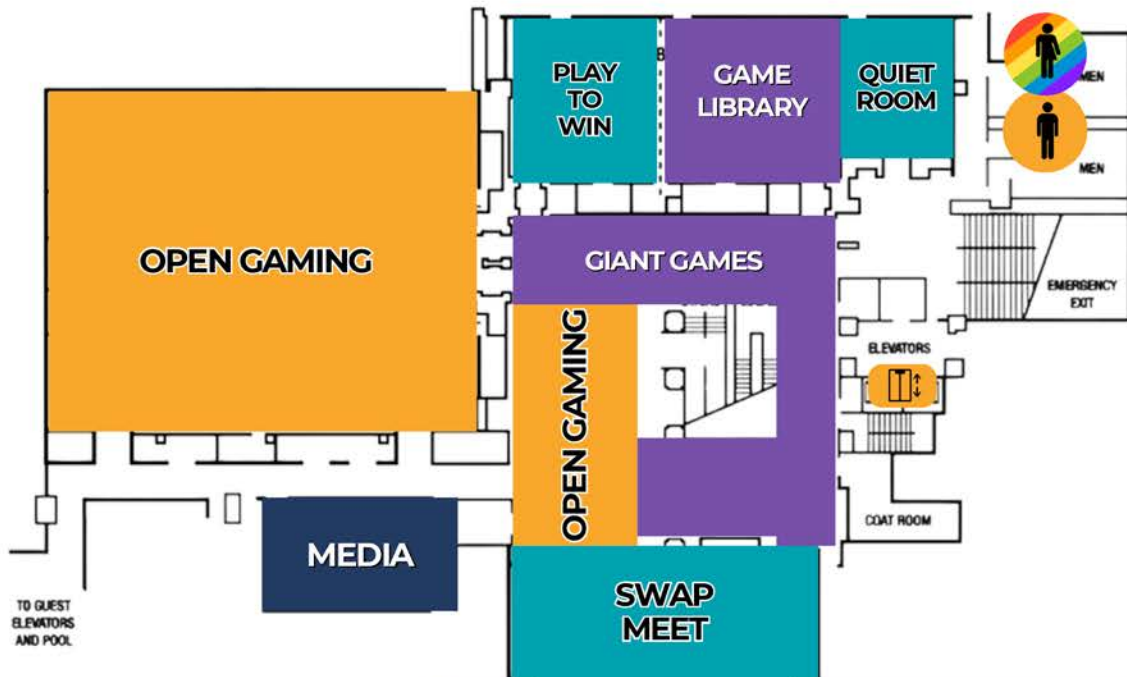

## MAIN LEVEL/FIRST LEVEL



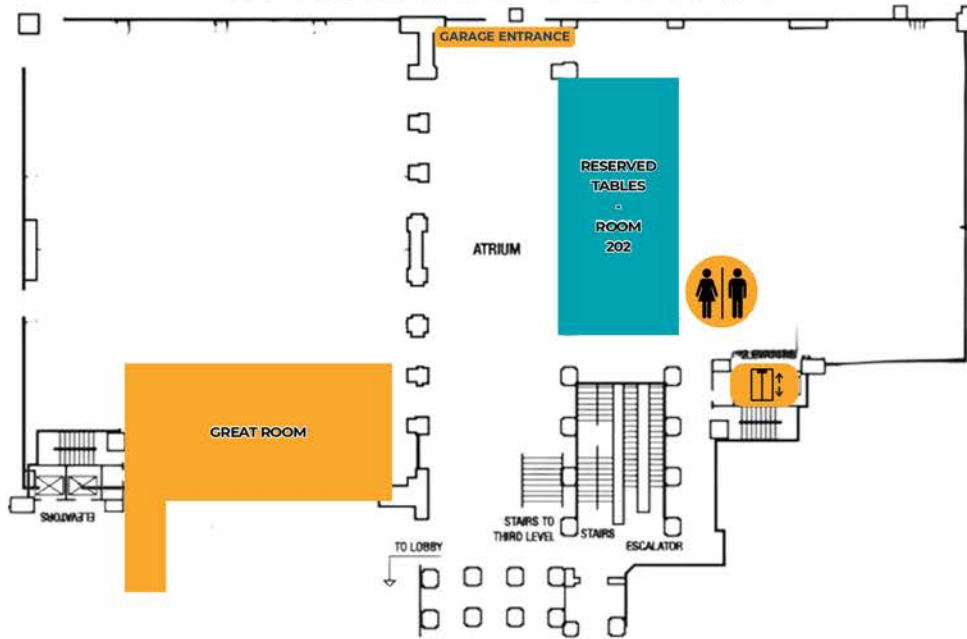

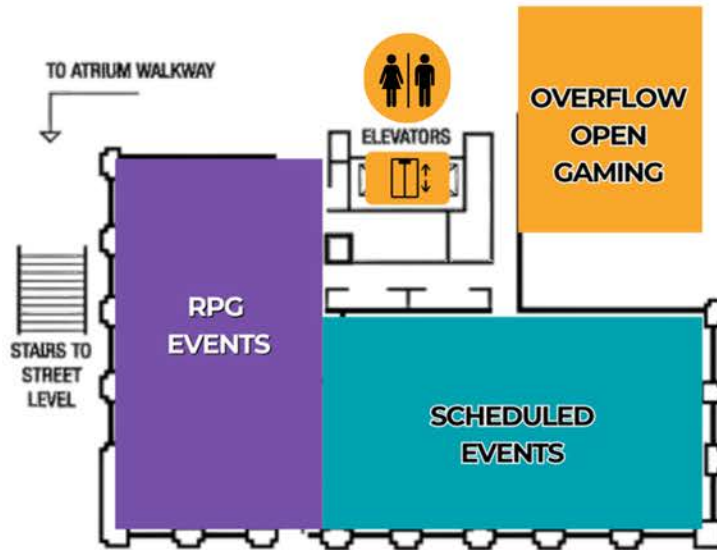

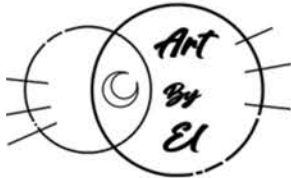
